

Education in Italy

To education abroad prestigious. And not just because it's abroad. In many European countries, the state carefully monitors the quality of education. And Italy is no exception to.

Italy has a multi-tier system of education. At school, Italians are studying the age of 13. The last classes, as a rule, the preparatory to admission to universities.

Italy offers a high quality education in the field of design, photography, fine art, art history. However, and other disciplines in Italy are taught with dignity.

Italian universities are divided into University and non-University.

To the University group includes all technical specialities, Economics, law.

To non-University group consists of institutes and academies that train creative professionals. For example, choreographic educational institutions of fine art. And as medicine, diplomacy, military specialty. The latter supervised by the relevant authorities.

The Italian education system does not imply that education need to pay exorbitant money. Therefore, the education in universities is relatively inexpensive. 800 Euro with public universities to 20 000 euros per private.

Training in some institutes and universities may be held in foreign languages. But to study in other necessarily need to pass the exam in the Italian language. Acceptable level B2.

In some educational institutions do not need to pass the entrance exams. To enroll you will need a document about finishing school or Lyceum.

But for enrolled foreign students must provide documentation not only of schools, but, for example, training at University for 1 year. Because Italians to University study for 12 years.

The curriculum at the Institute the student chooses himself. In addition to basic subjects, it is possible to acquire knowledge in allied Sciences. In the universities of Italy 4 session. Exams are mandatory. It is possible, on request, to reschedule delivery for a different time period. Monitoring visits in institutions and universities there. But the exam is very important the level of training. So it's best not to miss classes.

In Italy, as in most European countries, adopted a system of credits or points for students' knowledge assessment. It helps learners without problems is transferred from one European University to another without having to retake subjects.
